Championship Organization

Women: One Category

Men: Category 1-3 (no multiple registrations accepted – maximum one category per player)

Each couple plays a minimum of two matches.

In order for the tournament to take place at least 8 (men) and 4 couples (women) will have to be present.

Titles

Category ladies: Swiss champion

Category 1 men: Swiss champion

Category 2 men: Climber of the year

Category 3 men: Rookie of the year

Game rules

Group games possible, no Golden Point, champions Tie-Break possible.

Balls

All matches will be played with HEAD Padel Pro balls.

Umpires

All the matches will be played without a chair umpire.

Points

16+ couples → 500 Points

Up to 15 couples → 350 Points

Inscription fee

CHF 30.- per player. In cash before the start of the first match.

Send the completed form to: tournaments@swisspadel.ch. Only correct forms with required information will be taken into account.

Deadline

The deadline is on Saturday 8 September 2018 at 23:00. The maximum number of couples will be 32 per category.

Registration conditions

Only players having sent correct forms will be able to participate in the Championship. Federation licenses can be obtained from <https://swisspadel.ch/lizenziierung>. Only licensed players will be accepted (expect category 3). A player has to have Swiss citizenship or the main residence has to be in Switzerland.

Draws

Sunday, 9 September 2018. The information regarding the draws can be found on <https://swisspadel.ch>.

Tableau organization

The tableau will be done according to the ranking. The organizer will have the right make changes in the tableau.

Confirmation

Once the draw takes place, the participation will be confirmed in written and the participation of each player will be taken for granted. Couples which have not received a confirmation by Tuesday 11. September 2018 should contact the organization.

Schedule

Saturday 09:00 - 22:00

Sunday 09:00 - 20:00

The organizer will as far as practicable take into consideration the distance players have to travel to establish the matches' schedule. Players should be ready to play at least 15 minutes before the start of each match. Players not on time will be disqualified. The registration fee will not be reimbursed.
