2 courts outdoor, carpet. (A 3rd uneven court available, but it will not be used unless weather emergency.)

Championship Organization

Women: one Category

Men: Category 1 - 2 (no multiple registrations accepted - maximum one category per player)

45+: Men & Women can register in that same category.

In order for the tournament to take place draws will need at least 8 (men) and 4 pairs (women & 45+).

Titles

Category 1, Women, 45+ : Swiss champion

Category 2: Climber of the year

Game rules

No Golden Point, Group games & champions Tie-Break possible, depending on total matches.

Maximum of 3 matches per day.

Balls

All matches will be played with HEAD Padel Pro balls.

Umpires

All the matches will be played without a chair umpire.

HEAD

Points

16+ couples → 500 Points

Up to 15 couples → 350 Points

Inscription fee

CHF 30.- per player. In cash before the start of the first match.

Inscriptions

On Swiss Padel website.

Deadline

The deadline is on Saturday September 28th 2019 at 23:00.

The maximum number of pairs will be 32 per category.

Registration conditions

Only players having registered correctly through the website will be able to participate.

A valid Swiss Padel license is compulsory.

Players have to be Swiss citizens or to have their main residence in Switzerland.

Draws

Sunday, September 29th 2019. The information regarding the draws will be found on <https://swisspadel.ch> as of Monday September 30th.

Tableau organization

The tableau with seeded pairs will be done according to the ranking.

The organizer will have the right to make changes if w.o. occur before the competition has started.

Confirmation

Draws will be confirmed directly to players and the participation of each player will be taken for granted. Pairs who have not received a confirmation by Tuesday October 1st 2019 should contact the organization.

Schedule

Saturday 09:00 - 22:00

Sunday 09:00 - 20:00

The organizer will as far as practicable take into consideration the distance players have to travel to establish the matches schedule. Players should be ready to play at least 15 minutes before the start of each match. Players not on time will be disqualified. The registration fee will not be reimbursed.

Insurance
