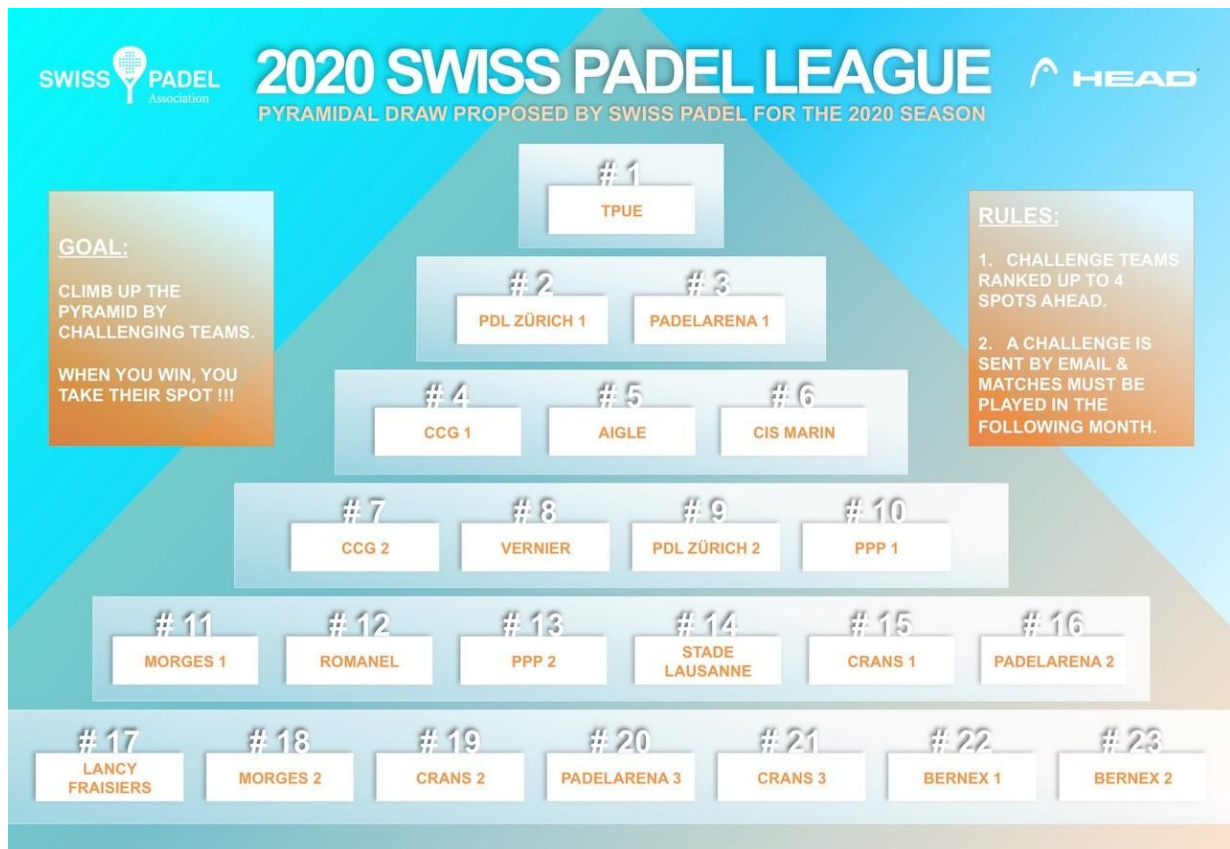


# RULES FOR INTERLCUBS PYRAMIDAL SYSTEM 2020

Pyramid JUNE 14th:



## RULES 2020:

- Each team can challenge any of the 4 teams ahead of itself on the pyramid.
- Both teams must agree on a date to play that encounter.
- Encounters can take place until Sunday November 15<sup>th</sup> included and at any day/schedule during the week (let's be flexible!)
- The team that has been challenged must propose a date & schedule and has the advantage of playing on its own courts (official SUIPA competition approved courts), but can let this advantage to the challenging team if wished or needed.
- A team that has been challenged and does not organize an encounter during the following month after receiving a challenge (date of e-mail) will automatically have its position taken by the challenger in the pyramid.
- Only 1 challenge at a time can be sent. Challenges are sent to another captain by email with copies at [manuel@swisspadel.ch](mailto:manuel@swisspadel.ch) You cannot accept nor send any additional challenge until the current one has been played.
- Format stays the same, 3 doubles for 1 encounter (men & women allowed), best of three.

- Doubles must be ranked 1 – 2 – 3 according to level of players. (Let's stay honest about it!)
- Composition of teams is free, with only one important rule: no player is allowed to play in 2 different teams during the season 2020.
- Order of play is also free between the 3 doubles, but if teams cannot agree, the order will be doubles number 3 first, then doubles number 2 and finally doubles number 1.
- Results of any encounter must be sent as soon as possible with the attached form to [manuel@swisspadel.ch](mailto:manuel@swisspadel.ch) and [reto@swisspadel.ch](mailto:reto@swisspadel.ch)
- No Interclubs Swiss Champion title will be given in 2020, as no Final rounds will be played.
- But the team on top of the pyramid on November 15<sup>th</sup> will be qualified for an European Championship, should this event take place in 2021. (If the team number 1 does not want to take part, then team number 2 will be qualified, then number 3!)
- No SUIPA team fee of 50 CHF will be asked in 2020.
- But all players will need to have an active SUIPA license when they play.
- Receiving team ensures that there is no rental fee for the visiting team and ensures that buying food and drinks on site is feasible (providing snacks when receiving a team is welcomed!)

New teams could be added during the season in the pyramid, should new clubs wish to take part, but those new teams will be added at the last position of the pyramid!
