## Championship Organization

Categories: Women / Men Open / Juniors / Vets 45+  
In order for the draws to take place a minimum of 8 pairs (Men) and 4 pairs (Women, Juniors & 45+) will be needed.  
*Junior draw Saturday Sept. 26th. All other draws: 6 best ranked teams in main draws on Sunday Sept. 27th and eventual qualifying draws on Saturday Sept. 26th.*

## Titles

Swiss champions 2020 in each category.

## Game rules

No Golden Point, Group games & champions Tie-Break possible, depending on total matches.  
2 matches minimum for each pair and maximum of 3 matches per day.  
All the matches will be played without a chair umpire.

## Balls

All matches will be played with HEAD Padel Pro balls.

## Points

16 pairs and over → 500 Points to winners (see points allocation on SUIPA website "Turnierreglement 2020" or "Règlement des tournois 2020")  
Up to 15 pairs → 400 Points to winners (points allocation like a Gd Slam draw)

### **Inscription fee**

CHF 30.- per player. In cash before the start of the first match.

### **Registration conditions**

Registrations have to be made through SUIPA website, with a valid Swiss Padel license.

Players must be Swiss citizens or have their main residence in Switzerland (exceptions can be approved by SUIPA for non-resident players working in Switzerland and playing yearlong competitions in CH.)

The maximum number of pairs will be 22 per category. If more than 22 teams register in one category, the SUIPA ranking points will define the list of entries.

### **Deadline**

The deadline is on Saturday September 19<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 23:00.

### **Draws**

Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup> 2020. Should be known as of Monday September 21st.

### **Tableau organization**

The tableau with seeded pairs will be done according to the SUIPA ranking.

The organizer will have the right to make changes if w.o. occur before the competition has started.

### **Confirmation**

Draws will be confirmed directly to players and the participation of each player will be taken for granted. Pairs who have not received a confirmation by Tuesday Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup> should contact Manuel F.

### **Schedule**

Saturday – Sunday 09:00 - 21:00.

The organizer will as far as practicable take into consideration the distance players have to travel to establish the matches schedule. Players should be ready to play at least 15 minutes before the start of each match. Players not on time will be disqualified. The registration fee will not be reimbursed.

### **Insurance**

Each player is responsible for his own insurance.

### **Prizes**

Prizes will be given from ½ final in Men Open and from finals in all categories.

Welcome present to each player.

Winners of each category get 2021 licenses.

Best Swiss teams (M & W) qualified for 2021 European “Champions Cup” with little cash support.

### **Rules**

If any query or doubt arises, the Swiss Padel Association Rules will be consulted.
